We, the delegates of the Youth Forum recommend to the General Assembly:

- To have clear commitments to the implementation of a meaningful youth IPPF strategy, including through concrete goals to evaluate improvement, especially with the inclusion of marginalised groups.
 We envision a strategy that emphasises and that sets the stage for youth centred action.
- To ensure the direct involvement of youth in the IPPF rebranding process. Local and global digital communication and educational strategies, such as CSE, need to be informed by youth to be relevant for adolescents and youth.
- 3. To ensure that IPPF prioritises core funding for the six regional networks and programs, separated from other MAs. We will be in charge of proposing, designing, executing and following up on projects relating to the youth with the key principles of youth-led accountability in place.
- 4. To co-create and engage in learning programs to build our capacity within the governance structures and strategies
- 5. To co-create and engage in a permanent regional and global platform where youth can share and connect, both within Member Associations and the regional youth networks. We recognize the differences in accessibility, and we need to tackle them together.
- 6. To ensure that MAs in each country are safer spaces for all youth, where their participation is embraced and encouraged.
- 7. To create a mentorship program at the global and national level, so that we enable intergenerational growth and sustainable development of the Federation. We will pave the way for future generations through meaningful youth participation.
